



Bethany, Missouri: Where the Journey Meets Home

Tucked along the rolling farmland of northern Missouri, Bethany is more than a dot on the map—it's a place where history, hospitality, and the open road come together. Located at the midpoint between Des Moines, Iowa, and Kansas City, Missouri, Bethany sits conveniently at the crossroads of Interstate 35 and Highway 136, making it a natural stopping point for travelers. Yet for many, what begins as a brief pause along the journey quickly becomes a favorite destination worth returning to again and again.

A COMMUNITY SHAPED BY HISTORY

Founded in 1845 and officially incorporated in 1860, Bethany proudly serves as the county seat of Harrison County. The town was originally named Dallas before being renamed Bethany in 1846. Built around Sugar Creek, early Bethany flourished as a regional trade hub by the mid-1800s. Steam saw and grist mills powered local industry, while hotels, churches, and shops supported a growing population rooted in agriculture and commerce.

The arrival of the Chicago, Burlington and Quincy Railroad in 1880 marked a turning point. Rail access, followed by additional lines, fueled economic growth and led to a significant population increase by the end of the 19th century. Bethany quickly earned a reputation as a key trading center in northwest Missouri—one that balanced progress with a strong sense of community.


SMALL-TOWN CHARM WITH BIG CONVENIENCE

Today, Bethany is home to just over 3,000 residents and serves as a central hub for surrounding rural communities. Its location along the I-35 and Highway 136 corridor makes it one of northern Missouri's most traveler-friendly stops, offering easy access to dining, lodging, fuel, and services without the congestion of larger cities.

This corridor brings a steady flow of visitors—from families and vacationers to snowbirds and long-haul travelers—moving between the Midwest's major destinations. Bethany's consistent hospitality, reliable amenities, and relaxed pace stand out along the route, creating a welcome contrast to long hours on the interstate.

A TRUSTED STOP THAT FEELS LIKE HOME

For many travelers, Bethany is a tradition. Familiar favorites like Toot Toot's Family Restaurant and Lounge have been

BENJAMIN PRENTISS (1819-1901)

The Civil War General who was ordered by General William Tecumseh Sherman to hold the Hornet's Nest in the Battle of Shiloh, was postmaster of the town and is buried here.



BABE ADAMS (1882-1968)

A professional baseball player who played for the Pittsburgh Pirates and pitched in three World Series games, lived in Bethany.



BEULAH MARGUERITE POYNTER (1883-1960)

An actress, author, and playwright was raised in Bethany.



FRANK BUCKLES (1901-2011)

The last surviving United States veteran from World War I, was born in Bethany.

BETHANY MEMORIAL SKATE PARK

The Memorial Skate Park is a dedicated, free, outdoor space for skateboarders, inline skaters, and BMX riders featuring various concrete, street-style obstacles. The fenced 60' by

45' concrete pad offers two-quarter pipes, stair structure and a wedge, flat, wedge, structure with a grind ledge, a square grind rail, a grind box and two bank ramps.

DUNN RANCH PRAIRIE

The Nature Conservancy's Dunn Ranch must be considered one of the few jewels in the middle of the country when it comes to the restoration and preservation of native lands.

Dunn Ranch Prairie boasts breathtaking views of expansive grasslands, a thriving bison herd, hundreds of vibrant wildflower species and over 100 species of birds.

Just minutes north of Bethany, Harrison County is home to the Dunn Ranch Prairie, a nearly 4,000 acre nature preserve managed by the Nature Conservancy, known for its tallgrass prairie restoration, bison herd, and role as a research and conservation hub. It features a mix of original unplowed prairie and restored areas, offering visitors hiking, bird watching, and bison viewing opportunities, with a short nature trail and observation deck for public access. The preserve is a key part of the larger Grand River Grasslands Project, focusing on landscape-scale conservation for species like the greater prairie chicken.

On the wide-open rolling expanses of Dunn Ranch and Pawnee Prairie, the prairie chicken still performs its colorful spring “blooming”; the upland sandpiper’s ghostly call carries in the wind; and regal fritillary butterflies alight on gorgeous cone flowers. The area is marked by high vegetation from late spring through fall. Large rolling hills make for a moderate hike. It is frequently windy, and spring can be very cool and breezy on the prairie. In summer it is often very hot, with little shade. Beware of bison on the Dunn Ranch. Some or all areas of the preserve may be temporarily closed due to restoration efforts. Observation deck is open to the public. Tours available, please call the Dunn Ranch office at (660) 867-3866 prior to your visit. ■

Harrison County has several public lakes where any angler can wet a line with the dream of landing that big fish, including the Harrison County Lake and not one, but two Bethany City Lakes.

BETHANY CITY RESERVOIR

Old Bethany City Lake
North of Bulldog Avenue on Highway 69.

The old Bethany City Lake is an 18-acre lake located inside Bethany's city limits, North of Bulldog Avenue on Highway 69. This lake offers a shelter house, public restrooms, picnic area, and ADA accessible fishing dock. The lake is stocked with large bluegill and channel catfish.

NORTH BETHANY CITY RESERVOIR

NEW BETHANY CITY LAKE

North on Highway 69 for approximately 2 miles, then W 280th Street west 0.25 mile to area entrance.

The New City Lake, built in 1960 as a supplemental water supply for Bethany, is a 73-acre lake also located North of Bethany on Highway 69. The lake is surrounded by 71 acres of open timber and is an ideal location for fishing and camping. The lake has a small boat dock, public restroom, ADA accessible fishing dock, picnic areas and camping sites. The lake is stocked with large mouth bass, channel catfish, bluegill and crappie.

HARRISON COUNTY LAKE

Accessible via Route W and W222 Street - Travel 9 miles north of the city of Bethany on County Road W. Turn west on W 222nd Street (gravel) for about 0.5 mile to the main lake entrance.

The Harrison County Lake, managed by the Missouri Department of Conservation (MDC) is a 280-acre recreational lake built in 1994 as a water supply and recreational reservoir. The lake provides a great location for water skiing as well as fishing and camping. The lake is stocked with bass, channel catfish, crappie, redear sunfish and bluegill. The County Lake has two shelter houses, a boat dock and two swimming areas and restrooms. ■

The Missouri Department of Conservation (MDC) manages three public wildlife areas in Harrison County, which provide an abundance of outdoor opportunities to area residents and visitors to the county.

GRAND TRACE CONSERVATION AREA

Bethany, MO 64424

From the west end of Main Street in Bethany, take Route W north 2.5 miles, then Route F west 5.5 miles to the west entrance of the area.

The Grand Trace Conservation Area located just southeast of Martinsville on the western side of Harrison County total 1,526 acres with a diverse habitat. Grand Trace has a variety of recreational opportunities, including bird watching, bicycling, fishing, hiking, hunting, and wildlife viewing. Grand Trace is managed for deer, wild turkey and quail and includes three fishable ponds. Indian hunting camps were common here. One main trail, the Grand Trace, connected the small seasonal villages of the area with the St. Louis trading center, located at the confluence of the Missouri and Mississippi rivers.

PAWNEE PRAIRIE NATURAL AREA

The Pawnee Prairie Wildlife Area approximately 476 acres abuts the Nature Conservancy's Dunn Ranch Prairie,

adding acreage in the restoration and preservation process on the tallgrass prairie project. The Pawnee site located in the northwest part of Harrison County represents a relict island of the once vast, rolling prairie of Northwest Missouri. Plants and animals unique to a tallgrass prairie ecosystem survive on portions of the area that have never been plowed. The remainder of the area is in various stages of prairie restoration.

WAYNE HELTON MEMORIAL STATE WILDLIFE AREA

Fox Creek Township, MO 64642

From Bethany, take Highway 136 east 9 miles, then Route CC south (right) 3 miles to the area.

The Wayne Helton Memorial Wildlife Area totaling 2,560 acres is located approximately 10 miles east of Bethany and a couple miles south. The northwest corner of the area includes the Helton Prairie Natural Area, one of the best examples of native prairie in north Missouri. Nearly 200 native prairie plants have been identified on the 30-acre natural area. The diversity of wildflowers in the area is tremendous, especially notable from mid-May until early July. ■



4. FIRST CHRISTIAN CHURCH

- 1901 Alder Street, built in 1916.

5. POST OFFICE

- 1407 Central Street, built with Treasury Department funds, 1939. See mural inside.

6. POYNTER HOUSE HOTEL

- 1400 Main Street, 1882 H.D. Poynter hotelier was also a merchant and band leader, son Victor, a jazz musician and daughter, Beulah Marguerite, and actor, author and playwright.

7. HARRISON COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY MUSEUM AND EDNA CUDDY MEMORIAL HOUSE AND GARDENS

- 1304 Main Street and 1218 Main Street are both open by appointment, Cuddy Home (Italianate architecture).

8. 10TH STREET FOOT BRIDGE

- Built 1905, Bethany Falls Limestone outcropping and former Bethany Roller Mills site.

11. 12TH & MAIN

- NW corner limestone courtyard garden.
- SE corner former JH service station.

12. THE SQUARE

- 1408 Main established 1874, Dunn Brothers, Cuddy & Templeman Mercantile. Mid 19th Century, The Dunn Family homestead what is now Dunn Ranch & Prairie Nature Conservancy north of Bethany.
- 105 S 15th Street, second Poynter House Hotel
- 1510 Main Street, Cole Hardware, founded by Cole family 1898. Wood floors and balconies.
- Harrison County Courthouse, 1938-1940, funded by WPA. Senator Harry Truman laid cornerstone. Current courthouse replaced a red brick courthouse depicted by Thomas Hart Benton in "Courthouse Oratory." See Toilets ground floor west side. See Frank Woodruff Buckles Memorial, Harrison County native and nation's last surviving WWI veteran. Appeared before Congress age 108 advocating for a WWI Memorial on National Mall. He died in 2011 at age 110.
- Veteran's Memorial also on grounds.
- 1520 Main Street, originally First National Bank
- 1600 Main Street, originally Dr. F.C. Smith's Drug Store
- 100 N 16th, originally Harrison County Bank, built by Hiram Wheeler 1884. Building apex originally read "Bank Block".


